

Save on Duty and Tax on Shipments to Canada

The United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA), aka “the new NAFTA” went live on July 1, 2020. The new trade agreement has massive implications on cross border e-commerce to Canada – learn how you can take advantage today.

WHAT'S CHANGING

The USMCA increases the tax and duty de minimis¹ in Canada; however, the new de minimis values apply to non-postal shipments only.

Tax De Minimis

20 CAD → 40 CAD

(15 USD) (30 USD)

Duty De Minimis

20 CAD → 150 CAD

(15 USD) (112 USD)

¹De minimis is a threshold exempting imports from duty or tax.
